
# Introduction

The Western Balkans Investment Framework (WBIF) is a joint initiative of the European Commission, financial institutions and bilateral donors for coordinating flagship investments in the region. This collaborative 'Team Europe' approach provides a unique offer of EU grants and loans blending, guarantees and technical assistance. The WBIF is the main vehicle for implementing the EU's Economic and Investment Plan for the Western Balkans 2021-2027, contributing to the socio-economic development and European perspective of the Western Balkans.

The importance of communication and visibility actions is outlined in the main WBIF governing documents – the Rules of Procedures and the General Conditions of the European Western Balkans Joint Fund. The WBIF Communication and Visibility Plan and Guidelines provides details on the awareness-raising and the promotional activities through a selection of communication tools, targeted at institutional partners, as well as the final beneficiaries in the Western Balkan region.

These Guidelines are crucial to assist key WBIF stakeholders with their implementation of communication and visibility actions in a coherent manner. It is incumbent on all partners in EU-financed activities to demonstrate EU support. In the case of WBIF, it means using the WBIF visual identity and related material included in these guidelines. In addition, the Guidelines offer concrete guidance on how best to coordinate multi-stakeholder communication and visibility activities, with a focus on investment projects.


The Guidelines are updated on an annual basis and shared amongst the WBIF Project Financiers' Group (PFG) Members, usually in the spring meeting. They present details on the WBIF visual identity requirements, main communication messages related to WBIF, an overview of planned events and activities, and examples of the portfolio of tools available to the WBIF Members through the website. The Guidelines also highlight the main results achieved from June 2023 to June 2024. An annual communication and visibility questionnaire measures the impact of WBIF's communication actions, a summary of which can be found in annex.

# 2.7. What is the Western Balkans Investment Framework?

## What is WBIF?

The Western Balkans Investment Framework (WBIF) is a joint initiative of the European Commission, financial institutions and bilateral donors for coordinating flagship investments in the region. This collaborative 'Team Europe' approach provides a unique offer of EU grants and loan blending, guarantees and technical assistance. The WBIF is the main vehicle for implementing the EU's Economic and Investment Plan for the Western Balkans 2021-2027, contributing to the socio-economic development and European perspective of the Western Balkans.

## Partner organisations

The Western Balkans Investment Framework (WBIF) was launched in December 2009 by the European Commission, the Council of Europe Development Bank (CEB), the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD), the European Investment Bank (EIB), bilateral donors and Western Balkan beneficiaries. The KfW Development Bank on behalf of the German Federal Government (KfW) and the World Bank Group (WBG) subsequently joined the platform, followed by the Agence Française de Développement (AFD). Most recent partners include the International Finance Corporation (IFC), the largest global development institution focused on the private sector in emerging markets, and the European Investment Fund (EIF), a specialist provider of risk finance to benefit small and medium-sized enterprises.

## **Broader WBIF context**

The Economic and Investment Plan for the Western Balkans 2021-2027 (EIP) was adopted by the European Commission in October 2020 to spur the long-term economic recovery of the region and foster regional socio-economic integration. The plan allocates a substantial financial package of up to €9 billion in EU grants, together with the Western Balkan Guarantee Facility potential to mobilise up to €20 billion, to help reduce the cost of financing for both public and private investments. 59 flagships have been endorsed since 2020, €2.3 billion EU and bilateral donor grants for €8 billion estimated total investment.

The EU Growth Plan for the Western Balkans was launched at the end of 2023 as a strong tool for accelerating the reforms in the path to accession for Western Balkans' economies. It is based on 4 pillars: Enhancing economic integration to the EU Single Market; Boosting the Common Regional Market; Accelerating fundamental reforms; Increasing financial assistance through a Reform and Growth Facility. A total of €6 million is made available, at least half going through the WBIF, the other half in direct budget support.

#### **Flagship investments**

The EIP identifies 10 flagship investments to support a green, bring the region closer to the EU.

#### Public sector support

The WBIF provides grants for energy, environment, social, transport and digital infrastructure to public entities or public-private partnerships. The successful implementation of the investments shows many tangible gains, such as significantly reduced travel times and increased transport safety, more energy from renewable sources, improved educational levels, as well as increased competitiveness.

#### Private sector support

The WBIF supports private sector development - notably micro, small and medium-sized enterprises - to become more competitive and integrate into global supply chains. To unlock the potential of the private sector, increased EU financing is made available through blending of grants and loans, and guarantees under the Western Balkans Guarantee Facility (EFSD+). This reinforces open, innovative, business-friendly eco-systems. Innovative funding options through guarantees and blending reduces the cost of financing for public and private investments as well as minimising risk for investors.

#### **Bilateral donors**

Selected flagship investments are supported jointly by WBIF Bilateral Donors and the EU in line with the Team Europe approach. The WBIF Bilateral Donors contribute directly to the Western Balkans Investment Framework Joint Fund in support of a sustainable and green transition in the Western Balkans. As of March 2024, 20 investments have been co-financed by Bilateral Donors for a total estimated amount of €525 million. Active Bilateral Donors as of March 2024 are: Austria, Croatia, France, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Luxembourg, Norway, Poland, Slovenia, Spain and Sweden.

#### **Blending and guarantees**

Blending uses public money (grants) to get a development project off the ground, with public and private investors financing the rest. Blending allows partners to get the most out of their grant resources and enhance their overall development impact. WBIF supports blending operations in both the public and private sector.

Guarantees share the risk of associated with lending, to encourage private investors and development banks to fund entrepreneurs and projects. In case something goes wrong, the EU will cover part of it. The Western Balkans Guarantee Facility, launched in 2020, is expected to mobilise investments of up to €20 billion in the next decade. It is financed through the European Fund for Sustainable Development Plus (EFSD+) and the External Action Guarantee.

#### **Technical assistance**

WBIF provides support for preparing and implementing sound investment projects, such as cost-benefit analyses, environmental and social impact assessments, comprehensive risk assessments and project management.

- Smart and sustainable mobility in Western Balkans technical assistance project develops strategic documentation needed for the deployment of smart and sustainable mobility in the Western Balkans and provides a detailed roadmap for the decarbonisation and digitalisation of the transport sector.
- · Flood protection measures ensure effective and rapid preparation of flood protection investment projects.
- Technical assistance increases transport efficiency and improves traffic safety by developing detailed designs for motorway alignment, including tunnels and bridges.

#### The Global Gateway

The Global Gateway is Europe's offer for connecting the world through sustainable and high-quality investments, taking into account the needs of partner countries. Supported investments have a wider regional spillover effect and accelerate the green energy transition by facilitating sustainable investments and connectivity. They are accompanied by soft measures that improve the policy, regulatory and business environment, develop skills, foster innovation and transfer technology.

- The Trans-Balkan Electricity Corridor: With EU financial assistance, Serbia and Montenegro are establishing a Trans-Balkan Power Corridor to connect the electricity transmission systems from Serbia, Montenegro, Bosnia and Herzegovina to Croatia, Hungary, Romania and Italy through either 400 kV overhead lines or submarine cable.
- Vau I Dejës floating solar photovoltaic power plant: A 12.9 MW floating solar photovoltaic power plant will be installed at Vau i Dejes, producing over 18 GWh of electricity and displacing 8,700 tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> annually.
- Corridor VIII is a multi-modal transport corridor which runs along the East-West axis from Italy through Albania, North Macedonia and to the Black Sea in Bulgaria. It is one of the Economic and Investment Plan flagship investments, integrating the region to the EU core transport network.

#### **Team Europe**

The 'Team Europe' approach combines resources from the EU, its Member States, and financial institutions, in particular the European Investment Bank and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development. It promotes a coordinated, multilateral response to the coronavirus pandemic and its social and economic consequences.

# **3.2. Communication Mix**

## Online

WBIF website - www.wbif.eu remains the main window into WBIF activities and results, and repository for all projects, publications and information for beneficiaries. Major updates for 2024 include:

- Private Sector webpage refit to present all active instruments targeting MSMEs, with an interactive map
- integrated presentation of instruments previously consolidated under WBIF (REEP, EDIF, EFSE, GGF)

Social media channels - Facebook, twitter/X, youtube and Instagram - provide latest news, beneficiary testimonials and significant results to a wider audience interested in the development of Western Balkans and archive of WBIF videos. Continued efforts to promote the channels are made through cross-posting and integrated communication (during events, on publications).

News flashes/Newsletter - Newsflashes provide up-to-date information on milestone events and activities for the WBIF stakeholders. Quarterly newsletters ensure a comprehensive insight into WBIF activities, decisions by governing bodies, and partner news.

# **Events**

WBIF-organised events target beneficiaries in both public and private sector. Key events for 2024 include:

- · 2<sup>nd</sup> Open4Business event, targeting MSMEs in the Western Balkans. Co-organised with Chambers of Commerce and with the participation of IFIs
- Public sector events

# 3.3. WBIF 15<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

This year marks the 15<sup>th</sup> anniversary of WBIF.

Since 2009, over €3.7 billion in EU and bilateral donor grants have been allocated for infrastructure and private sector projects for a total estimated investment of €31 billion – equivalent to one-third of the GDP of the entire Western Balkans.

WBIF supports the ambitious Economic and Investment Plan for the Western Balkans in sustainable transport, clean energy, environment and climate, digital future, human capital and private sector competitiveness, building on the Connectivity Agenda (2015 - 2020) focused on transport and energy infrastructure.

The new Growth Plan for the Western Balkans, adopted in November 2023, will accelerate the implementation of fundamental reforms with the potential to double the size of the Western Balkan economies within the next 10 years.

So far, under the EIP, 59 flagship investments are bringing tangible benefits to the region, such as:

- 2,000 MW additional capacity in renewable energy
- 400 km of railway lines rehabilitated
- 170 km of motorways built
- Clean drinking water for 825,000 people
- 200,000 children enrolled in EU-supported schools
- 350,000 people with access to internet
- · 343,000 MSMEs supported with access to finance







# **Partnerships & Collaborations**

Putting the Team Europe approach into practice requires close collaboration with implementing partners - IFIs, EU Delegations, Chambers of Commerce, media and other relevant organisations involved in the Western Balkans. Coordination is key, to ensure timely preparation before events take place, and impactful communications after events. Particular attention in 2024 will be given to::

#### **REEP – KfW & EBRD**

The Regional Energy Efficiency Programme in the Western Balkans (REEP) aims to create a sustainable energy efficiency market in the region. The programme provides a combination of financial instruments for private sector and individual households, technical assistance and policy dialogue support for public institutions to overcome market obstacles and stimulate long-term market growth.

REEP is implemented by the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) and the German Development Bank (KfW) with the support of the EU and other bilateral donors. To date, REEP has provided more than €300m in credit lines and €150m in direct lending for 1,000 SMEs, more than 12,700 households and 290 public buildings. This has contributed to almost 1 million MWh/yr in energy savings.

REEP Plus is identified in the European Commission's Economic and Investment Plan for the Western Balkans as one of the flagship projects within the "Renovation Wave" under the investment window "Clean Energy". These projects contribute significantly to the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions, and improve the living standards and health of citizens.

#### Connecta

The Technical Assistance to Connectivity in the Western Balkans - 2 (Connecta 2) is funded by the European Union in response to the Western Balkans' need of technical assistance for the implementation of the Connectivity Agenda, the Economic and Investment Plan and the roll-out of the Growth Plan.

Connecta provides 'rapid response' technical support, facilitating the kick-start or finalisation of major projects in digital future, clean energy and sustainable transport sectors. It also assists with preparing and implementing national and regional transport connectivity reform measures. WBIF will convey Connecta news/calls for beneficiaries and feature stories showcasing the impact of the technical assistance.

#### **EU4Green**

The Project EU4Green aims to support the Western Balkan 6 in implementing the Green Agenda, the EU's regional strategic roadmap against the climate crisis, and to initiate the corresponding reforms. WBIF will publish relevant stories from EU4Green when linked to WBIF investments, and share green agenda content for publication by EU4Green.

#### **Road Corridor Vc**

The beneficiary - public company Autoceste FBIH - is regularly documenting the progress of construction of the EU-supported sections. In coordination with the EUDEL, the media reports are published in major media outlets. A series of Transport Safety videos were produced by the beneficiary, as well as bilboard campaigns along the Corridor.

# 4.1. Partner channels

#### DG NEAR

Sharing information on a weekly basis with the Communication unit of DG NEAR ensures that relevant announcements are shared on official EU Commission channels for a wider outreach. The WBIF prepares regularly updated Tables of deliverables for planning of the milestone events.

#### **EIB/EBRD** Channels

To support the EIB and EBRD visibility departments in developing success stories, the WBIF provides background information, video/photo material for the EIB Blog and EBRD website. The EIB stories are promoted additionally on the WBIF/DGNEAR channels.

#### **EU Delegations**

Close cooperation with the EUDELs in the preparation of the milestone events (start/completion of works), and providing video/photo coverage if requested and factsheets if available. The EUDEL/IFI-produced press releases on the events are further promoted on WBIF channels.

#### **Chambers of Commerce**

Collaborations with Chambers of Commerce focus mainly on private sector-targeted activities, in particular the Open4Business event taking place in September 2024. In coordination with the CoC, the MSMEs are selected for video/photo coverage and success stories.

#### Media

The mandate of WBIF communication activities is focused on providing attractive and effective communication materials for our partners to carry out campaigns and outreach activities to a wider audience via local and national media. However, targeting selected regional media organisations with feature stories can show the added value of WBIF investments across the Western Balkans. Feature stories will be pitched to Euronews, Forbes and Euractiv - all present in the region.



The evaluation for 2023-24 showed that WBIF's main stakeholder knowledge of WBIF operation and performance is 4.08 on average (on a scale from 1-5), an increase on last year's average (3.95). Yet, many participants were not, or not sufficiently aware of (for example) the B2F campaign (and workshop). Therefore, a stronger emphasis on deeper coordination with partners and clearer guidelines for them is included in this year's plan.

Other suggestions for improvement focused on increasing media outreach and visibility in local media outlets. While these activities are not directly in the remit of WBIF, supporting materials can be provided to partners and beneficiaries to support their outreach activities.
